INVESTOR IN AFRICA MAGAZINE INTERVIEW WITH MR. JIT BHURJI

1. When did you start selling farm machinery?

36 years ago.

2. What motivated you to get in the Agriculture industry?

The agriculture industry is the heart of any country. Food is not a luxury but a necessity. How to produce food and make it affordable to everyone in the country it is the machinery that is going to achieve that. Food has to be produced commercially with the growing population. To innovate and built agricultural machines that do this work is the most economical way of producing food commercially while protecting the soil.

These machines are very important because they are used in every step of the agricultural processes from first tillage, secondary tillage, planting, harvesting, transporting and logistics to the factory for processing to the end consumer.

3. What types of farm machinery equipment do you have?

Tractors, cultivators, planters, spreaders, harvesters, trailers, cleaning for grains, storage facilities – the whole circle up to the last section where one cleans and stores their grain ready for the millers.

4. Among all the farm machinery, which types are the fast-moving and why?

Our farms are becoming smaller and smaller.

We deal with the large scale farmers but they don't buy machines more often every year. At the moment, farmers are the ones who purchase our machines regularly when they have financing. They buy our tractors, relevant implements behind it. For the small farmers, they don't have farms big enough for them to buy proper equipment and there is no formal rental equipment company in Kenya where they can rent these equipment and machinery.

5. What is the biggest challenge you have encountered in the distribution of farm machinery?

The distribution of farm machinery faces a lot of challenges more-so from products coming from China and India that are far much cheaper and have really infiltrated the market. This has made it difficult to experience industrial growth in this sector due to unending competition and price wars.

6. What would you say have been the biggest changes in the Agricultural sector and how has it affected the farm machinery purchase decisions of your target market?

The major effect on the agriculture industry is that the land is being cut into too many small pieces through traditional systems of land subdivisions that come into play. Land subdivision has become quite a huge challenge because this has made it even more expensive to use machines to plow small land parcels. This, in turn, reduces yields and raises the cost of agricultural production which does not favor the growth of this sector.

Climate change is also hitting us drastically and has also become a major challenge due to the unexpected changes in weather and climate patterns. This poses a high risk of loss to farmers since agriculture in Kenya widely relies on suitable weather patterns for its success. Other temporary issues such as bank lending and interest caps for the agriculture sector as well as agricultural insurance are also there but they can be fixed.

In conclusion, we are very anxious to see how policies change and how the farmers are empowered and the farming sector becomes a real player that is regarded as an imperative sector in the country. This is because it is the food that produces a population that will make this country survive.

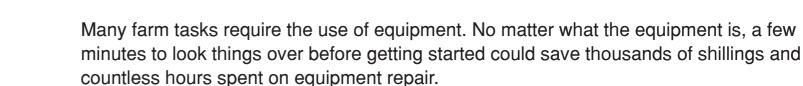

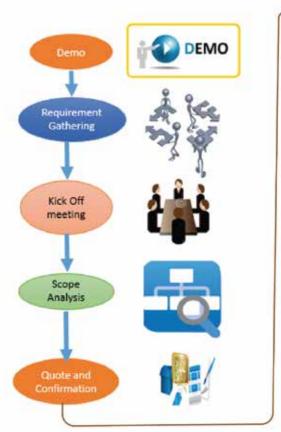

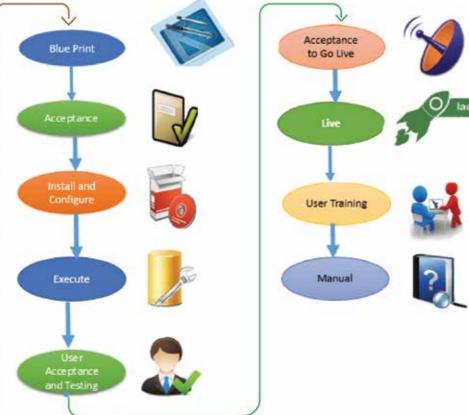
